

# Create an escape plan for your home

Use the hazard map for reference to talk with your family about when, where, and with whom you should evacuate to make an escape plan for each type of disaster.

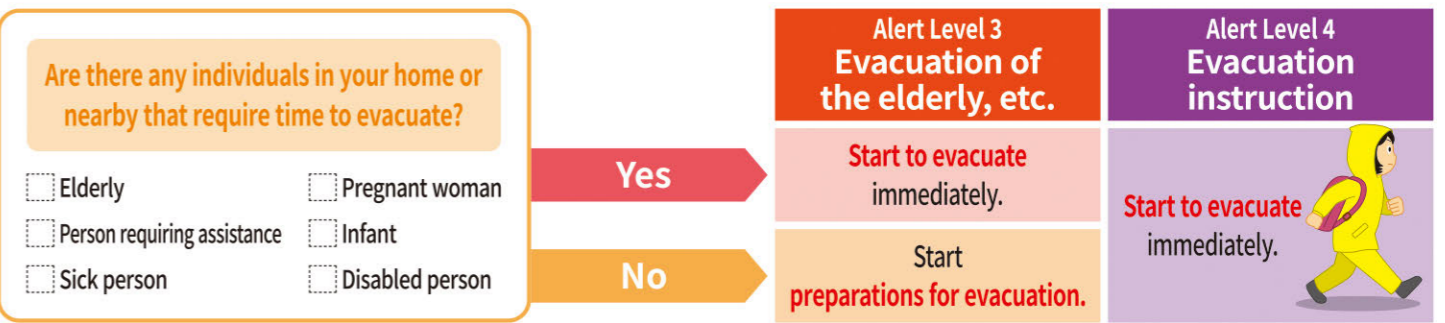
**5 Check the inundation risk areas for tsunami and the inundation depths!**

\*Evacuation point: Safe home of a family member or acquaintance, designated general evacuation shelter, etc.

## Evacuation preparations

In preparation for evacuation, always keep a ruck sack, etc., filled with essential items in a location that is easy to access. When evacuating, carry things on your back so that you can use your hands, and wear safe clothing that allows easy movement.
